Very Helpful Tips For Videos:

WOW Moments: Edit and curate the most exciting, unexpected, funny, or impactful moments from streams. These are prime for viral potential.

Trends: Keep an eye on trending challenges, memes, or seasonal events, and craft clips around them. Also you can suggest ideas to me.

Unexpected Twists: Edit your clips to emphasize surprising moments. Add "Wait for it..." or "Hear his answer..." text overlays to build suspense and keep viewers hooked. Viewer retention is important.

Music Syncing: Use suitable (perhaps lofi for chill and trance for buildup) copyright free (aka royalty free) music. Interactive Polls or Questions: Post a clip and ask viewers to weigh in with comments (e.g., "What would YOU do in this situation?" "How would you answer this question?").

Reactions: Suggest videos for me to react to or topics to talk about. Or even insert your own reactions to the stream clips.

Be Playful: Play with the edits if you'd like, as much as you'd like. Talk smack about me through text on screen or use silly sound effects and meme popups, I don't care. Go all out as much as you'd like. Sometimes more stuff like this can keep people engaged and also help build your own personality as the editor people know.

Track Performance: Use analytics to see what's working and double down on similar content. Experiment often, and adapt your style based on audience feedback and trends.

Mimic Other Creators: A good channel to copy in strategy regarding editing, thumbnails and titles could be Asmongold TV (which inspires the effectiveness of this whole idea) or the on-street content by Nuance Bro, Fleccas Talks, Mark Dice and Slightly Offensive. Please don't be too obnoxious, and be respectful to the individuals in videos.

Step-by-Step (The 5 Steps):

- 1. Read Tips. Download VODs in order to edit, from the dedicated VODs YouTube channel.
- 2. Filmora for editing videos easily.
 - For Shorts: 9:16 format and under 60 seconds to fit platforms like YouTube Shorts, TikTok, and Instagram Reels. Shorts do good with more editing or text.
 - For Videos: 16:9, 1080p, 6k+ Bitrate (lower saves space).
- **3.** Open videos with VLC Media player then Ctrl+Shift to Screenshot for Thumbnail Base Template. No need for shorts thumbnails.
- **4.** Photoscape X for editing thumbnails easily, 1920x1080, export as JPG or PNG. Do your best to make it look professional, maybe compare to others for similar content. Change color settings, maybe add contrast and vibrance and clarity, maybe add vignette, maybe add text outlines/glows.
- 5. Upload to Platforms. Read Tips.
